Request for KTDFA Final Approval Louisville Pickleball, LLC (2)

Project Description

The applicant is proposing a tourism attraction project, specifically an entertainment facility in Lyndon, a Louisville suburb.

The total estimated project cost is nearly \$22.7 million. The maximum sales tax rebate, up to 25 percent of project costs, is estimated at \$5.7 million.

Type of Tourism Development Project

As indicated by the Applicant and confirmed with the consultant report, the project will meet the following criteria:

- Total eligible costs shall exceed \$1 million.
- In any year, including the first year of operation, the tourism development project shall be open to the public at least 100 days.
- In any year following the third year of operation, the tourism attraction project shall attract at least 25 percent of its visitors from among persons who are not residents of the Commonwealth.

Consultant Report

The project was reviewed by an independent consultant and determined to have a net positive fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The Office of State Budget Director and the Finance and Administration Cabinet approved the consultant's recommendations and have certified the report and the findings with a Certification of Net Positive Economic Impact to the Commonwealth. The total incentives to the project granted over the ten-year duration of the agreement shall not exceed \$4,012,000.

Final Approval

By granting final approval, KTDFA will enter into a tourism development agreement with Louisville Pickleball, LLC which will include, but not be limited to, the estimated project costs, maximum amount of recovery, term of the agreement, and the date by which the project will be substantially completed.

Project Description

Maker's Mark Distillery in Loretto is proposing to develop a tourism attraction project, specifically an entertainment facility, on its campus.

The total estimated project cost is \$18.5 million. The maximum potential sales tax rebate, up to 25 percent of project costs, is estimated at \$4.625 million.

Type of Tourism Development Project

The Applicant indicated that the project will meet the following criteria:

- Total eligible costs shall exceed \$1 million.
- In any year, including the first year of operation, the tourism development project shall be open to the public at least 100 days.
- In any year following the third year of operation, the tourism attraction project shall attract at least 25 percent of its visitors from among persons who are not residents of the Commonwealth.
